Talent Acquisition

2024 saw an increase of 44% to the employee base! With the expansion of the Russell Food store, the Foxwarren Agro and the resulting employee moves, transfer and advancements, the HR team was kept busy . We were pleased with the level of interest from the communities, holding over 120 interviews for open positions within our Co-op.

Professional & Personal Development

A 'Building Your Personal Brand" curriculum focused on product knowledge and customer service was developed with Home & Building team and continues today.

Within the Agro, Class 1 training proved successful as three individuals increased their skills and enhanced our ability to provide customer service during the season.

Food - with over 100 team members providing front facing customer service within our Food division, it is common to see some movement and there may be career opportunities to consider in the future.

Professional Development investments with the University of Manitoba, Athabasca University, the Credit Institute of Canada and Safety associations have seen seven individuals pursuing designations in their respective fields. Twin Valley Co-op invests in employee development through sponsoring tuition costs

Our teams went through some great losses this past year, losing friends and team members such as Chris Mercer – Birtle Home Centre, Marylou Leclerc-Birtle Food and Mike Twardoski – Russell Agro.

Total Rewards

Two main reasons for choosing to apply to Co-op were often mentioned in interviews. Applicants stated they had 'heard' Co-op was a good place to work and cared about its people, was community focused and the second was the compensation package was fair and competitive within the retail market. Our compensation package offers more than just a paycheque but is interwoven with a consideration to offering a comprehensive benefits plan, a 6%/6% matched pension plan, health & wellness program and other team perks to provide a total reward for team members living and working here. An increase to our vacation rates occurred in 2024 bringing us well above Employment Standards. The implementation of a self-funded Short-term Disability program is in place for times when injury or illness may impact our people. The Interest Free Employee Purchase program and the Employee Purchase Discount plan continue to be popular incentives.

Diversity & Inclusion

Our Co-op has grown to foster a diverse, equitable, and inclusive workplace culture focused on employee well-being. We welcome many cultures among our team members who each bring a unique perspective to the work we do.

Youth

Our young people are our future – and we show our investment through the hiring and training of young people throughout our retail commodities. This strategy provides an opportunity for our young people to grow their interpersonal skills providing friendly customer service to our members. We celebrate each year when our students graduate, having 22 student graduates in 2024 and offering \$3,700 student merit awards at graduations.
