Welcome to our latest newsletter.

As you are aware, 2023 was a busy year for us. Construction began on the new food store in Russell which we are expecting to open June 1, 2024. The Fertilizer Plant on Highway 16 is also underway with an expected opening this Spring.

In 2023, we added a DEF Dispenser and a shower/washroom facility to the Russell Card Lock on Highway 16 that are anticipated to be available very soon.

Tesla superchargers were added to the services offered at the Russell Gas Bar. As a point of interest, we do not own the superchargers. We set aside some property to have them installed on; however, the equipment is owned and operated by Tesla. There are also two generic chargers at that site as well.

Our 2023 sales finished just under \$122 million, just shy of our total last year. We experienced logistical and supply issues in a few of our commodities that affected our year. We are looking forward to an excellent year in 2024 and are expecting to be past those hurdles this year.

As you will see in the newsletter, there is much happening within Twin Valley Co-op and a lot of excitement for the coming year.

### **TIPS FROM IT**

Beware of Suspicious Emails – Recognizing Phishing Attempts

As technology and the digital world continue to evolve, one of our greatest risks is phishing – a technique cybercriminals use to trick you into giving away your personal information. Spotting phishing attempts is crucial for staying safe online.

Phishing often, but not exclusively, occurs via email. These messages may seem to originate from legitimate sources like banks, popular retailers, or government agencies, aiming to steal sensitive information like usernames, passwords, credit card numbers, banking details, and SIN numbers.

Despite their convincing appearance, complete with pictures and logos, these emails often contain hints of their true nature. Below are a few key indicators:

**1. Urgent or Threatening Language**: Phishing emails typically create a sense of urgency or fear, claiming that your account may be closed or that immediate action is needed to avoid serious consequences. Remember, legitimate organizations won't pressure you like this via email.

**2. Requests for Personal Information**: Exercise extreme caution with emails asking for personal details. Genuine companies rarely request sensitive information through email. If unsure, avoid clicking any links; instead, visit the company's website directly or use a phone number from their official website or a phone directory, to confirm their need for information.

**3.** Suspicious Email Addresses: Scrutinize the sender's email address. Phishing attempts often use addresses that appear legitimate at first glance. For example, support@amaz0n.com uses a zero instead of an 'o'. Most email programs allow you to hover over the email address to see the full details.

**4. Grammar and Spelling Errors**: Professional organizations are meticulous in their communications. Poor grammar and spelling are common indicators of phishing emails.

5. **Unfamiliar Greeting or Tone**: Be wary of emails that don't address you by name or use generic greetings like "Dear Customer." The tone of the email may also not match what you would expect from the organization.

In conclusion, remain vigilant with your emails and guard your personal information as you would your wallet. When in doubt, avoid clicking links or downloading files from suspicious messages.
