Deep Roots - A look back at the 90 Year Celebration for TVC

As we reflect back on 2019 and all the ways that we celebrated our 90th year, one of our best memories was being in each community with our fundraising BBQ's. We celebrated with the communities of Birtle, Elkhorn, Miniota, Rossburn and Russell during the summer months with BBQ's where the funds were donated back to the local community. We also left a permanent marker in each town with the addition of our "You're at home here" community benches, located in playgrounds and areas where people can sit and rest on our benches.

Some of our other notable events were:

- Giving free onesies to any TVC member who had a baby in 2019; starting in January
- We sold bread for 29 cents a loaf on Feb 6
- Rolled fuel price back to 1929 prices for one winner at each Gas Bar on March 29
- Celebrated our 90th Anniversary on our incorporation date of April 15, 1929
- In May, we visited with Bob Blelloch, 101yrs old as he told us of his days working for TVC at the Birtle Lumber yard when he was the Manager
- In June, July and August we held our Community Fundraising BBQs
- September 17th was Fuel Good Day where proceeds raised were donated to local Fire Depts
- We celebrated Co-op Week October 13-19th with a number of online contests
- On November 13, 20 & 27th we did our "Check Out" Game in our Food Stores and at Russell Home Centre on December 4th.

We are now taking applications for the FCC Lead with Seed program. Take advantage of No Interest and No Payments until Oct 1, 2020. Deadline for applications is Jan 30, 2020.

It's time to review your FCC Crop Input limits. If you require an increase, please speak to one of our Ag representatives or contact Audrey Zenchyshyn, Credit Manager at 204-859-3299 or email a.zenchyshyn@twinvalleycoop.ca.

FCC Crop Input and Lead with Seed payments are due Mar 15, 2020. You may choose to pay at one of our locations (cheque payable to Twin Valley Co-op) or you can pay FCC directly on line through on line banking.

Note that your Crop Input and Lead with Seed balances accrue interest daily. You must obtain the balance the day you are making payment to payout completely. You can get that information at FCC online www.fcc.ca or phone 1-888-522-2555.

Twin Valley Co-op is now offering Scotia Bank Yield More Financing as another financing option. If you would like to apply or need more information, please contact one of our Ag representatives. One piece of government issued photo ID is required at time of application; example: driver's license or passport.
